CHECKLIST TO PREPARE FOR YOUR DOT PHYSICAL

Cadillac Urgent Care uses only medical examiners certified through the FMCSA. We want to ensure that your DOT physical exam process is efficient and thorough. To prevent delays in getting your DOT medical certificate, please bring the following with you if they apply.

	Valid driver's license
	Your current or expired Medical Certificate (MSCA Form 5876)
	Eye glasses or contacts
	Working hearing aid
	List of all medications
	Be prepared to give a urine sample to check for sugar and blood in the urine.

	Non-Insulin Dependent Diabetics
	A recent copy of your Hemoglobin A1C (must be within 6 months)
	A letter from your PCP stating your sugars are under control.
	A letter from your Optometrist stating there is no diabetic retinopathy

	Sleep Apnea
	Current printout showing an AHI < 5 and usage more than 70% over 30 days

	Heart Conditions
	A letter from the cardiologist that you are safe to drive a commercial vehicle

	Chronic Medical Conditions/Surgeries
	If you had a recent surgery we need a letter from the surgeon that you are safe to drive.
	If you take Gabapentin, bring a letter from your PCP stating you do not have seizures.
	Call ahead with any questions you have and we will be happy to answer those.
